VISITS & TOURS

Private tours are available for groups of 15 people or more with a minimum of two weeks advance notice, and on a first come first served basis. If your group is smaller than 15, there are daily public tours that you can join. Please check our website for public tour time of the day. For information, contact us at grouptours@lansugarden.org. If your group is larger than 25, we will arrange for additional guides. Lan Su can only accommodate 60 students per hour. If the number of students exceeds 60, the group will have to split up into two hours. Please meet at the entrance courtyard to start your tour at the specified time. All tours are approximately 45 - 60 minutes.

SCHOOL TOUR BEHAVIOR GUIDELINES

Please discuss these important guidelines with your students and chaperones before arriving at Lan Su Chinese Garden.

- Lan Su is primarily an outdoor facility with covered walkways and unheated pavilions. We recommend that students dress appropriately for outdoor conditions.
- Help keep the garden tranquil by using quiet voices. There are other tours and guests in the garden who come to experience tranquility and quiet.
- Please stay on the stone pathways and respect any barriers and signs.
- Please walk. Do not run or climb on any stone or wood structures.
- To preserve their fragile beauty, please do not touch or pick the plants, wood carvings, and large stones.
- To ensure the health of our fish, please do not feed them or throw anything into the lake.
- Cell phones must be silenced.
- Group and class photography are allowed with the permission from the Visitor Services team.
- No food or gum is allowed in the garden. Food can be consumed in the plaza outside the garden, and please be sure to clean up after eating.
 Please inquire with a staff member if you need access to a garbage bin or trash bag.
- Outside drinks and water are permitted only if they have a lid. Glass bottles are never permitted in the garden.
- There is a Garden Shop next to the Ticket Booth. No more than five students are allowed at once and must be accompanied by an adult. The Garden Shop is a very small space with many fragile items.
- While exploring the garden, students must be accompanied by chaperones at all times. Chaperones will be responsible for the students' behavior and making sure the group is adhering to our garden policies.

ACCESSIBILITIES & SPECIAL NEEDS

Lan Su Chinese Garden is a wonderful place for all people to experience a 2,000-year-old tradition that melds art, architecture, design, and nature in perfect harmony. As the Garden is built with authentic Chinese techniques and materials, below are a few helpful hints for your group.

Lan Su has a wheelchair accessible route that travels throughout the garden and Universal Access Maps are provided at the entrance. Almost every area of the garden can be accessed by those using mobility devices, and benches are available throughout the garden. Restrooms are also fully accessible. An elevator in the Teahouse allows patrons with limited mobility to access first and second floor seating.

- Please watch your step as you visit:
 - o Some pathways are created with slightly uneven river rock
 - o Pathways are narrow
 - o There are several places with two steps and no handrail
- At the entrance, there is a Universal Access Route Map available for wheelchairs and to help other mobility devices navigate the Garden. Mobility devices are not provided at Lan Su.
- We encourage chaperones visiting with assisted living groups to ensure the safety and enjoyment of the group. For safety reasons, it is helpful if the chaperones stay with the group the entire time they are in the garden.
- Please stay on the pathways.
- Lan Su is one city block with only gentle inclines.
- There are many covered areas with seating to enjoy the Garden.
- There is a Teahouse on site that is accessible.

PARKING

Lan Su Chinese Garden has free first-come, first-served parking located on Flanders Street & 3rd Avenue. Street and paid parking are also available.

BUS PARKING

There is a bus loading and unloading zone on the NW Corner of NW 3rd and Everett which allows passengers to unload onto the sidewalk, not the street. Then simply walk across the street at the light to our entrance. The loading zone is in front of a business called *Fei Long Spa*. The bus may remain if the driver stays with the bus.

Bus parking options include metered on-street parking or call the City of Portland, Office of Transportation at (503) 823-5185 for locations where the driver can park and wait to return and pick up.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

Lan Su Chinese Garden is 2 blocks from the OldTown/Chinatown MAX station and near bus routes heading out of downtown: *Routes 1, 4, 5, 8, 10, 33, 40, 77*.

Driving Directions to Lan Su Chinese Garden

From I-5 North or South

Take the I-405 Exit

Take the Everett Street Exit

Turn East on Everett

Follow Everett Street to 3rd Avenue

We are on the corner of 3rd & Everett

On I-84 West

Take Interstate 5 North

Take Exit to 405 South (you will cross the Fremont Bridge)

Take the Everett Street Exit (first exit after you cross the bridge)

Go to the second light and turn left on Everett

Follow Everett Street to 3rd Avenue

We are on the corner of 3rd & Everett

From US 26 (Sunset Highway) East toward Portland

Take I-405 North

Take the first Exit, Everett Street Exit

Get immediately into the right land and turn right on Everett

Follow Everett Street to 3rd Avenue

We are on the corner of 3rd & Everett

BUS LOADING AND UNLOADING CAN BE DONE ON THE $NW \ CORNER \ OF \ 3^{RD} \ \& \ EVERETT$

There is on-street parking available for a fee.
